We are sorry that have experienced **problems with urban foxes** and would like to help you to solve these in a **non-violent way**.

Companies that profit from killing foxes make out that only a cull would solve all fox problems. This is not the case.

Dawn Scott, Professor of Mammal Ecology at Keele University states:

"Shooting foxes is not the solution. This is only a short-term "fix" and other foxes will move in. As they will be setting up territories, it is likely there will actually be more feaces as other foxes dispute the temporarily vacant territory. I would recommend to use humane deterrents on areas a school does not want foxes to defecate in to try to persuade them away."
